# **IMMUNOCONTRACEPTION CONFERENCE**

In Aug.2019, a 3 day "PZP Immunocontraception Conference" was held in Montana re non-lethal wildlife management, hosting >100 attendees from Bureau of Land Mgmt, U.S. Forest Service, NGOs, tribal communities, sanctuaries & universities. The majority are currently using the immunocontraception vaccine Porcine Zona Pellucida (PZP) as a humane, non-lethal & sustainable way to manage wildlife @ sites around the world. Program included study results for PZP use in managing (a)elephants in South Africa, (b)white-tailed deer in urban & suburban areas in the US & (c)wild borros in Arizona & to develop a longer-acting, replicable & costefficient PZP vaccine formula. Event organized by Montana-based Science and Conservation Center(SCC), sponsored by the Botstiber Institute for Wildlife Fertility Control & Zoo Montana.
