Vets are invited to get involved by providing low-cost or FREE S/N & rabies vacs for free-roaming cats. Now in its 11th yr, the efforts of >1,500 veterinary participants from USA, Canada, South Africa, Greece, Israel, Japan, Croatia, Antigua, Nicaragua, & India have S/N'd > 130,000 cats! Vets can sign up at www.saveacat.org/the-feral-fix.html & pledge to provide FREE or low-cost S/N to as many freeroaming cats as is feasible for their individual practices. (PS. I bet they don't each receive anything as prized & unique as our "Proud to Be A Lucky Star Vet Button!" 

) It is estimated that 860,000 cats are euthanized in U.S. shelters every year, many of whom are newborn kittens or unsocialized free-roaming cats. The two go hand in hand, as 80% of kittens entering shelters each year are born to free-roaming cats. Many die before getting there.
