These dogs & cats ...joined the already high # of stray animals on the streets, desperately searching for very limited resources. #s exploded rapidly, w/tens of thousands of puppies & kittens born on the streets ea. yr. Ukraine is now among the top 10 countries in the world w/the largest # of stray animals. One approach that offers a humane & sustainable solution however is the Trap-Neuter-Vaccinate-Return ... model-a programme that we have been successfully using in Afghanistan for many yrs now. In 2023, Nowzad was awarded the Global Alliance for Rabies Control Award for our TNVR work in Kabul, & it is something we're unashamedly very proud of."
